It's Not Too Late to Claim
Your Child Tax Credit!



If you haven't filed taxes to claim the Child Tax Credit (CTC), there's still time! Go to [GetCTC.org](https://www.getctc.org) TODAY to claim thousands of dollars that your family is owed from the Child Tax Credit.

You can receive:

- Up to \$1,800 per child 0–5 or \$1,500 per child 6–17, if you received advanced monthly CTC payments last year.
- Up to \$3,600 per child 0–5 or \$3,000 per child 6–17—the full Child Tax Credit!—if you did not receive advanced payments.
- And if your family missed the 2021 stimulus payment, you can receive that too!

You can claim the CTC TODAY in less than 15 minutes by visiting [GetCTC.org](https://www.getctc.org), an IRS–approved official E–file provider. Here's how:

- Go to [GetCTC.org](https://www.getctc.org)!
- Have your Social Security Numbers (SSN) or Individual Taxpayer Identification Numbers (ITIN) ready to use.
- **To qualify for this quick & easy filing service, your household must make less than \$12,500, or if married, less than \$25,000, and have less than \$400 in self–employment income.**
- NOTE: [GetCTC](https://www.getctc.org) can only be used to receive the CTC & missed 2021 stimulus payments. It cannot be used to claim the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) or other federal or state tax benefits.

What if my income is too high to use [GetCTC.org](https://www.getctc.org)? What if I want to file a full tax return?

- If you don't qualify for [GetCTC.org](https://www.getctc.org), or if you want to file a full tax return to claim the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) or other state or federal tax credits, there is FREE filing assistance:
 - Visit [GetYourRefund.org](https://www.getyourrefund.org), where you can file online for multiple years with the help of an IRS–certified tax preparer. (Income must be below \$66,000).
 - Find your nearest [Volunteer Income Tax Assistance](#) (VITA) site, where an in–person IRS–certified preparer can assist with filing your taxes (income must be below \$58,000).
 - Visit the [IRS's Free File portal](#), which will guide you through filing your taxes online. (Income must be below \$73,000).

File your taxes as soon as possible—there's thousands of dollars available through the Child Tax Credit!
